A TRIBUTE TO KEN BRAY



My father-in-law Ken Bray was a phenomenal person. He was born on 3/30/1930 and he died on 4/03/2025, a few days after turning 95 on 3/30/25.

He spent his life helping people, especially veterans. He was one of the Best People On Earth, BPOE in the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks. He was a 52 year member of Newpot Elks Lodge #273, in Cold Spring, KY.

He was also my dad for 47 of my 72 years,

after I married his son Danny. He was actually my friend prior to meeting his son. We rode the city bus TANK together everyday for months and we sat together and chatted daily before I arrived at my job in Cincinnati.

He was the best father-in-law ever, never a harsh word was said between us. In the past year of his life after we lost Mom, Ruth his wife of 73 years in January of 2024, we became closer. Since he was staying alone in his condo, and became more dependent on me and his sons Danny and Roger. He started learning how to cook for himself and would call me often for recipes. He became very proficient with his

crockpot and crockpot recipes. He was often my official taste tester since I often fixed him more difficult recipes. I would bring them over to him for dinner with extra containers full, to freeze. I loved cooking him special dishes.

He was my dad and I was the daughter he said he never had. He loved me unconditionally and I loved him dearly.

I will miss him forever and never ever forget him. He was the epitome of a good and loving father.

The Veterans enjoyed a ham dinner with mac-n-cheese, sweet potatoes, green beans, and dessert and then played bingo. A good time was had by all.




